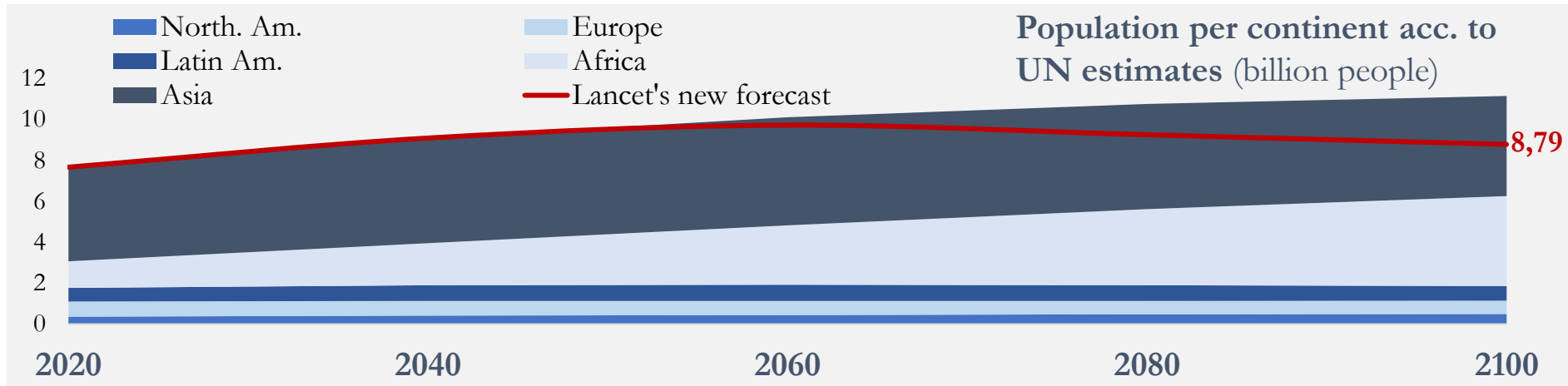
In 2100, Africa and Asia will be “demographic superpowers”, with 83% of the global population

Life expectancy at birth should increase by almost 10 years globally towards 2100

Japan will lose almost a third of its population by 2100. Germany, Russia or Venezuela will also face a sharp decline in population.



Although the UN predicted a peak of the global population in 2100 at 11.2 billion, a July 2020 study by the Lancet forecasts a peak in 2064 before falling to 8.8 billion by 2100, with 23 countries seeing populations shrink by more than 50%
