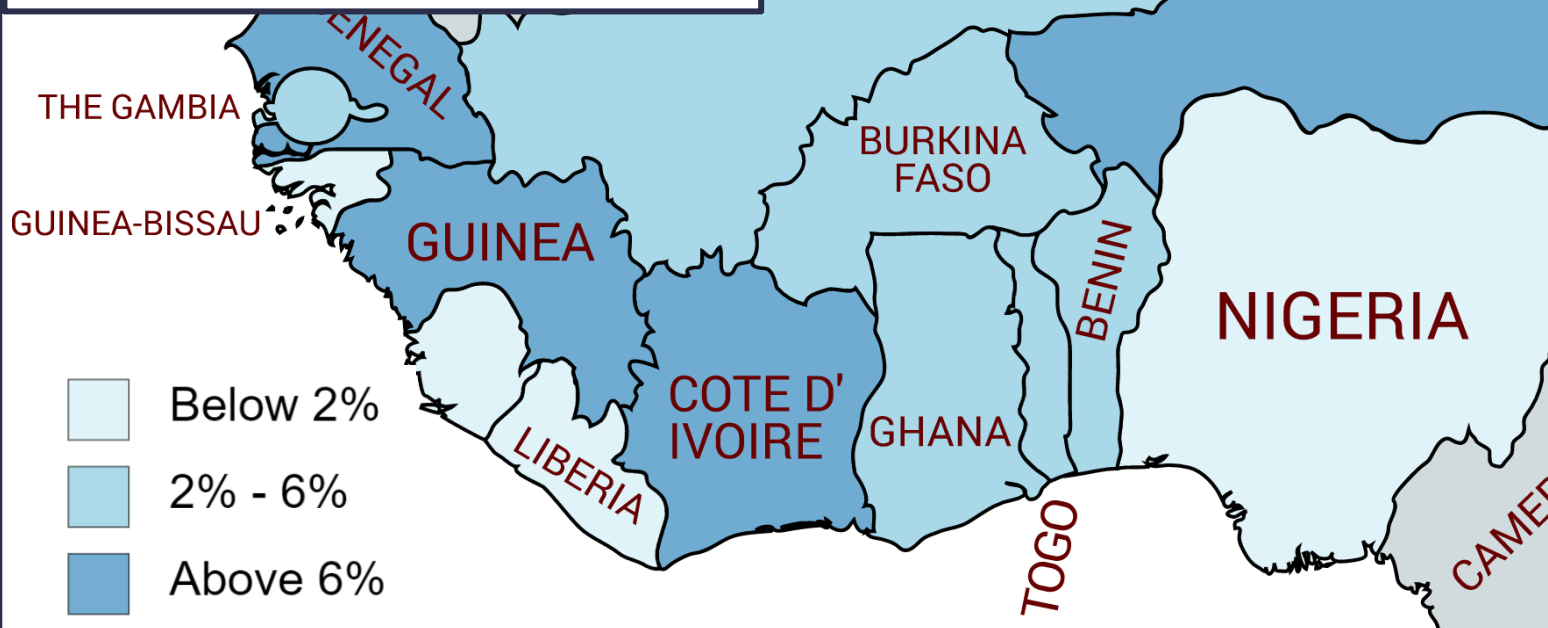

### Annual GDP growth 2015-2030 (average)



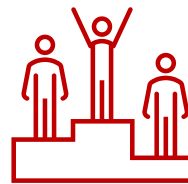
520 million

By 2030, more than 520 million people will live in Western Africa, from 400 million in 2020. Western Africa will be **15% more populated than the European Union**. Nigeria will account for half of the sub-continent total's population.



2.2tn

GDP should **double** between 2015 and 2030, reaching 2.2 trillion USD – more than the current GDP of **Italy, Russia** or **Canada**.



+107%

Cote d'Ivoire's GDP per capita is expected to increase by 107% in 15 years and become the **highest of Western Africa** in 2030, exceeding Ghana's. Senegal (+106%) should rank third, ahead of Nigeria.
